- Strattera is available to patients who need another treatment option due to side effects or contraindications to the stimulants^{iv}
- Strattera works differently from stimulants⁻⁻⁻⁻
- It acts on a chemical in the front part of the brain that controls attention, behaviour and emotion"
- Strattera starts to improve symptoms gradually^{*}

WHAT IT MEANS FOR YOU

- Strattera improves the symptoms of your ADHD, and will continue to improve them over time^v
- There is very little risk of addiction with Strattera^w
- You may start to feel some of the effects of Strattera at 1 week^v
- It can take around 6-9 weeks to feel the full effects of Strattera^{vi}
- If you experience any side effects, they should be mild to moderate^v
- Strattera works when you need it to, from early morning through to the evening^{vii}

Tips for taking Strattera

- Take Strattera at around the same time every day^v
- If you miss a dose, take it as soon as possible
- Do not take a larger dose than has been prescribed
- Capsules should not be opened[®]
- You can take Strattera with or without food food might help to reduce nausea^{voii}
- If you have any concerns, talk to your doctor
